Workforce Coalition

A first-of-its-kind collaborative effort to create a demand-driven training strategy that benefits all. By closely connecting employer skill needs to available career pathway support, the WNY Manufacturing and Tech Workforce Coalition will facilitate a more meaningfully aligned approach.

Family Code Night

A family-based approach to workforce development, in partnership with Microsoft TechSpark, that fosters cross-generational STEM engagement with Minecraft Education. This shared guardian-and-child experience offers a fun introduction to programming concepts while removing the common barrier of childcare.

PowerUpTech

Expanding the impact of this tech talent and retention program, designed for college students, that builds on the momentum of its first year successes and insights gained for a collaborative retrospective.

This is a concerted effort to reduce the region's 70% loss of tech grads.

A new integrated marketing strategy that leverages first-hand experiences to build meaningful audience connections. Our most powerful tool for transforming preconceived notions and reshaping the narrative around the varied possibilities that a career in tech opens across every industry.
